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| 02 | Military family pictures Overseas | As a member of the TRICARE Dental Program, or TDP, you're entitled to a great set of benefits whether you're stationed in the US or overseas. | |
| 03 | Smiling faces picture Text on screen "Government pays 60%" "Benefits: 2 exams 2 cleanings covered at 100%" Pregnant mom picture Third cleaning covered at 100% | Your dental health is important, and that's why the Department of Defense pays 60% of the monthly TDP premium for all active duty family members and most categories of National Guard and Reserve sponsors. Further, when using one of over 64,000 United Concordia participating dentists, you are covered with 2 exams and 2 cleanings at 100% during a consecutive 12-month period. Pregnant enrollees may receive a third cleaning covered at 100%! Your exams and cleanings do not apply to your \$1200 annual maximum benefit. | |
| 04 | On screen text \$1200 Orthodontics \$1500 lifetime maximum. | Yes, you do have an annual maximum benefit of \$1200 per TDP enrollee. But there are no waiting periods, no pre-existing condition clauses, as well as no deductibles with the TDP. You don't have to pay anything other than your monthly premiums and cost shares, if any, to receive your \$1200 annual benefit. Orthodontics, or braces, have a lifetime maximum of \$1500 per enrollee, and do not apply to the \$1200 annual maximum. There are age limitations for orthodontic care, so please see the chapter titled "Orthodontics" in your TDP Benefit Booklet for more information. | |

Cost is a factor when considering expensive dental services, such as implants, since they are subject to your \$1200 annual maximum, and you will most likely exceed it. | |
