



Attention Florida Residents:

United Concordia recognizes the impact **Tropical Storm Fay** may have had on you and your family. We have taken measures to ensure your dental needs are met and alleviate any concerns you may have. For any TDP enrollee residing in the Florida counties of **Brevard, Monroe, Okeechobee, and St. Lucie**, United Concordia has taken the following steps:

- United Concordia will withdraw any cancellations or nonrenewal notices issued on or after August 25, 2008 and reinstate the policy without a lapse in coverage.
- United Concordia will not issue cancellation or nonrenewal notices until November 10, 2008 or later, in certain circumstances.
- United Concordia is telephoning each participating dentist's office in these counties to ensure your access to dental care. We will assist you in finding a dentist should your office be closed.
- United Concordia will assist with reestablishment of lost or damaged dental records.
- United Concordia will assist with the continuation of orthodontic or prosthodontic treatment.

United Concordia hopes these actions will return some degree of peace of mind to our TDP enrollees affected by Tropical Storm Fay. We realize there may be circumstances that are not addressed by the actions listed, which may require additional action on our part to help you as you recover from this unfortunate event.
