

Employees Donate Supplies to Iraqi Children



In August 2008, the TDP Customer Service Activity Team sponsored a collection of back-to-school supplies to benefit Iraqi children. Through participation in this drive, employees donated an estimated \$250 worth of school supplies.

Five boxes, between 50 and 60 pounds each, were shipped to PFC Andrew

Robison; son of Lori Souders, TDP customer service representative; who is currently serving with his unit in Iraq. The supplies were distributed to a new children's school in the sector his unit is protecting.



In addition to supplies gathered by the activity team, Patti Railing, (TDP Enrollment & Billing), and her part-time employer, KB Toys in Chambersburg, Pa., provided a generous donation of marker and stationery kits for the children. Highmark also provided book bags. In addition, the TDP department provided a monetary donation to cover the costs of shipping supplies and postage.
